We are gearing up for our two biggest outreach events: **Pumpkin Patch** and **Fall Festival**! A couple of years ago we changed the focus of our Pumpkin Patch from a fundraiser focus to a community outreach opportunity. This means we are focusing on engaging and connecting with the people the Lord brings to the Pumpkin Patch. Visitors may come for a pumpkin, but we want them to walk away knowing that Trinity Baptist Church cares more about their eternal life! I recently preached about being obedient in striving to reach our world with the gospel of Jesus. This is the perfect opportunity for you to interact with the community and simply share the joy you have through a faith relationship with Jesus. We will also need help setting up the patch on Saturday, October 5th starting at 10:00 am! We will begin setting up pallets, tents, tables, and fencing to prepare for the arrival of the pumpkins that afternoon. At 12:00 pm we will have a break for pizza, salad and desserts. Then, the pumpkins are scheduled to arrive at 1:00 pm. If we have enough people, we will be able to get them all unloaded in about two hours. I hope you will be able to come out and lend a hand.

Mark your calendars for WORSHIP NIGHT IN THE PATCH on Sunday, October 13th from 6:00 – 7:00 pm. Jeremy & Crystal Tomlinson will be leading us in a time of worship outdoors, and you won't want to miss it! Jeremy is

the Worship Pastor at Journey Christian Church down the road from us, and his wife Crystal is a teacher here at TCS. I hope you'll join us for a wonderful night of declaring praises to God out in the patch.

We are looking for a few items for the pumpkin patch. If you have access to wooden pallets, please let us know. We need about 100 in total. I'd also like to purchase 3 new foldable, sturdy wagons to replace the one we currently have. They are roughly \$80.00 each. We are also looking to borrow a wheelbarrow to help move the rotten pumpkins from the patch to the trash area. You've heard us start asking for candy donations for our Fall Festival on Saturday, October 26th from 4:00 – 6:00 pm in the main parking lot.
